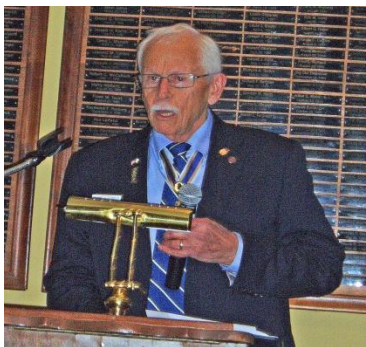
DMC Meets with UELAC in Kingsville
